

# Introduction to the Choir

Information for Families

# The Choir

The North Star Boys' Choir consists of four groups: two training choirs, the international touring choir, and a choir for older boys. All boys learn proper singing techniques, as well as good manners and respect for each other. Any boy can learn to sing; no experience required.

## **Music Magic**

Our youngest training choir, for beginning singers. Open to all boys 5-7 years old.

## **Cadet Choir**

The intermediate training choir. Typical age of boys is 8+ years old. They learn to sing in parts and in other languages, and they perform increasingly challenging music throughout the year.

## **Viking Choir**

The international touring choir. Typical age of boys is 9-14 years old. Boys are invited to join the Viking Choir, usually after singing in the Cadet Choir for a time. They learn to sing complex harmonies and rhythms, in multiple languages, using advanced techniques, based on the Viennese style of singing.

## Kantorei

For older boys who have "graduated" from the younger choirs. These boys provide the tenor and bass parts in certain songs and perform their own multi-part songs. They often serve as junior prefects to help guide the younger boys.

# **Rehearsals and Voice Lessons**

Music Magic: every Tuesday from 4:45 to 5:25 pm.

**Cadet Choir:** every Tuesday and Thursday 5:30 to 6:45 pm. Boys in the Cadet Choir also have a half-hour voice lesson each month.

**Viking Choir:** every Tuesday 6:30 to 8:00 pm, Thursday 6:30 to 8:00 pm (optional), Saturday 9:00 am to 12:00 noon, Saturday 1:00 to 2:00 pm (required for new Viking Choir boys, optional

for experienced boys), and Sunday 5:30 to 7:00 pm (optional, at Francis's house with pies!). Boys in the Viking Choir also have a half-hour voice lesson each month.

Kantorei: every Tuesday 8:00 to 9:00 pm.

All rehearsals are at Christ's Community Moravian Church in Maple Grove (13250 93rd Ave N). Voice lessons are at the church on Tuesdays, and at Francis's home in Elk River by appointment. (1797 Tipton Circle, Suite 112).

If your boy will miss rehearsal for any reason, he must call Francis in advance to let him know.

- **December/January:** all-choirs Christmas concert; regional concerts and church services during Christmas/Epiphany season (may include weekend overnights)
- March/April: church services during Easter season
- May: all-choirs spring concert
- **June:** national tour (international every third year)
- August: resident camp at Timber Bay Camp (with Cadet Choir)

#### Kantorei

- **December**: all-choirs Christmas concert
- May: all-choirs spring concert
- **June:** national tour with Viking Choir (international every third year)
- August: resident camp at Timber Bay Camp (optional, as junior counselors)
- August: day camp (optional, as junior counselors)

# Uniforms

# Costs

Monthly tuition pays for rehearsals, voice lessons, rent, and tour-bus transportation to select events. Part of the fee also covers the cost of sheet music, folders, concert uniforms, administration, and insurance. We email invoices monthly for online payment.
